

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-3

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE DAILY RATE FOR INCARCERATION

WHEREAS, Montana Code Annotated § 46-18-403(2) directs the Board of County Commissioners to annually establish by resolution the “credit for incarceration” rate, and

WHEREAS, § 46-18-403(2) also states that the daily credit for incarceration rate must be “equal to the actual cost” of incarceration, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the cost of incarceration on an average daily basis is \$69.63 exclusive of inmate medical costs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the daily incarceration rate is hereby established at \$69.63 per day plus any medical costs; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if a court judgment is for a fine and imprisonment until the fine is paid, the inmate shall be allowed a credit of \$69.63 for each day of incarceration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an inmate granted work release incarceration privileges shall reimburse Petroleum County at a rate of \$34.82 per day; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an inmate is responsible for actual costs of medication, medical services, or hospitalization while in a detention facility on the order of a Petroleum County court based upon the individual’s ability to pay and/or private provider health coverage or a bona fide and responsible third-party payor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Attorney shall initiated proceedings to collect from an inmate any charges arising from medical services or hospitalization in accordance with § 7-32-2245.


